- 400 Hazardous Materials Incidents including combustible spills, radioactive & biological, and electrical issues.
- 500 Service Incidents including water removal, smoke/odor issue, animal issue, and public service.
- 600 Good Intent Incidents including unknown type of alarms, controlled burns, steam mistaken for smoke.
- 700 False Alarm Incidents including unintentional fire alarms.
- 800 False Alarm Incidents including malicious alarms, bomb scares.
- 900 Special Incidents including citizen complaints, special types and miscellaneous incidents.

AUGUST INCIDENTS:

- 95 dispatched fire incidents with 620 volunteer man-hours.
- \$90,000.00 of property was in danger of fire loss in Columbia Borough.
- \$0.00 of property was destroyed in Columbia Borough.
- 0 firefighter injuries reported.
- 0 firefighter exposures reported.
- Response time for first arriving fire truck in Columbia Borough (from dispatch to arrival) for the month of **August** was **7:26**.
- Friday was our busiest day with 39 incidents.
- Incidents by shifts and our average number of volunteers:
 - > 07:00am 02:59pm 33 incidents averaging 10.9 volunteers.
 - ➤ 03:00pm 10:59pm 43 incidents averaging 15.9 volunteers.
 - ➤ 11:00pm 06:59am 19 incidents averaging 05.4 volunteers.
 - All Shifts 95 incidents averaging 12.0 volunteers.
- Water Rescues were our most dispatched incident type with 28.
