- 0 firefighter exposures reported.
- Response time for first arriving fire truck in Columbia Borough (from dispatch to arrival) for the month of **April** was **5:01**.
- Saturday was our busiest day with 12 incidents.


- Incidents by shifts and our average number of firefighters:
