300	Rescue/EMS Incidents including vehicle accidents, water rescue, searches, and industrial rescues.
400	Hazardous Materials Incidents including combustible spills, radioactive & biological, and electrical issues.
500	Service Incidents including water removal, smoke/odor issue, animal issue, and public service.

- Response time for first arriving fire truck in Columbia Borough (from dispatch to arrival) for the month of **December** was **7:08**
- **Saturday** was our busiest day with **15** incidents.

 - 07:00am – 02:59pm **22** incidents averaging **10.7** volunteers.
 - 03:00pm – 10:59pm **25** incidents averaging **14.3** volunteers.

- 11:00pm – 06:59am **15** incidents averaging **13.0** volunteers.
- All Shifts **62** incidents averaging **12.7** volunteers.
- **Rescue** was our most dispatched incident type with **16**.
