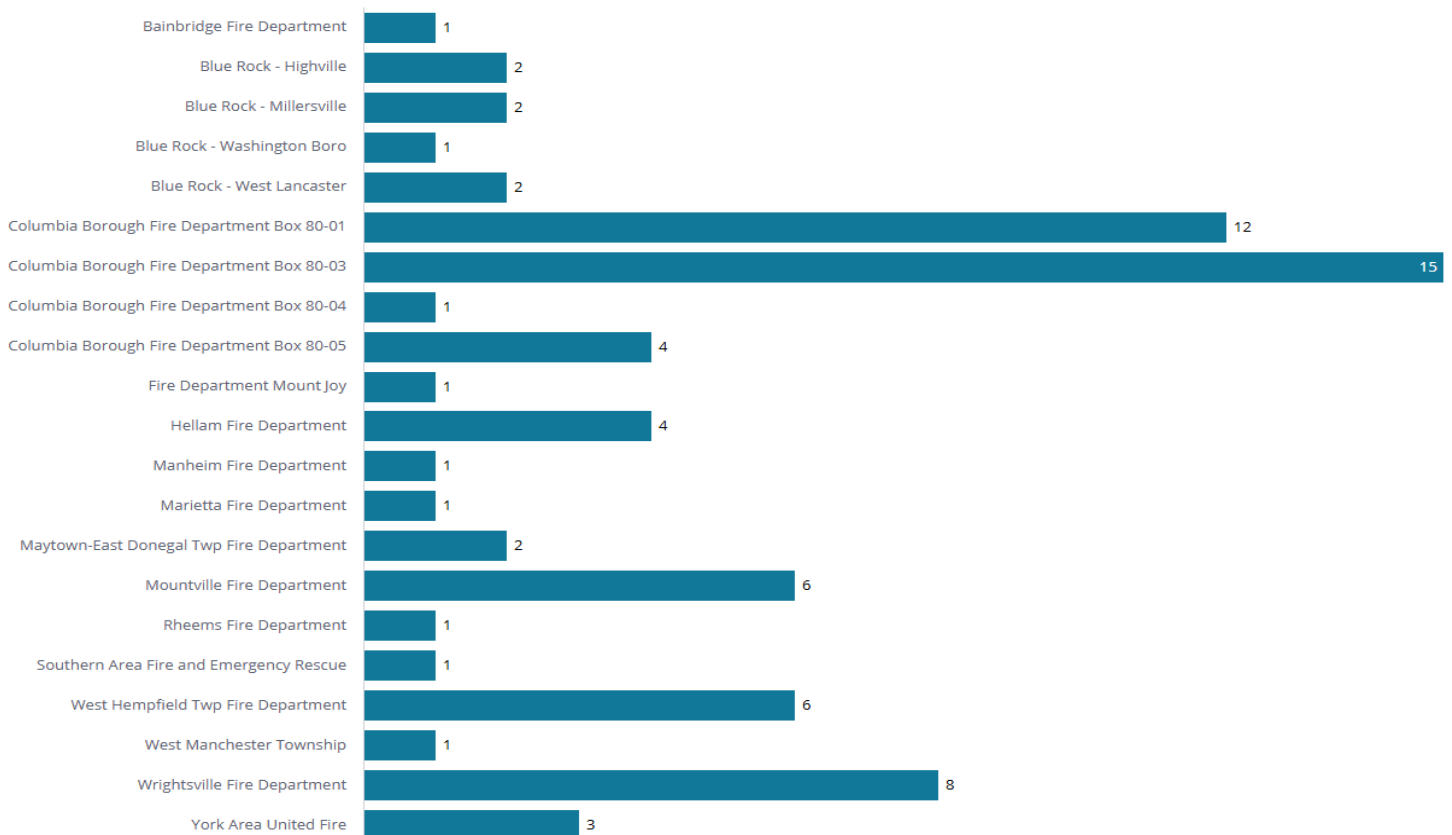

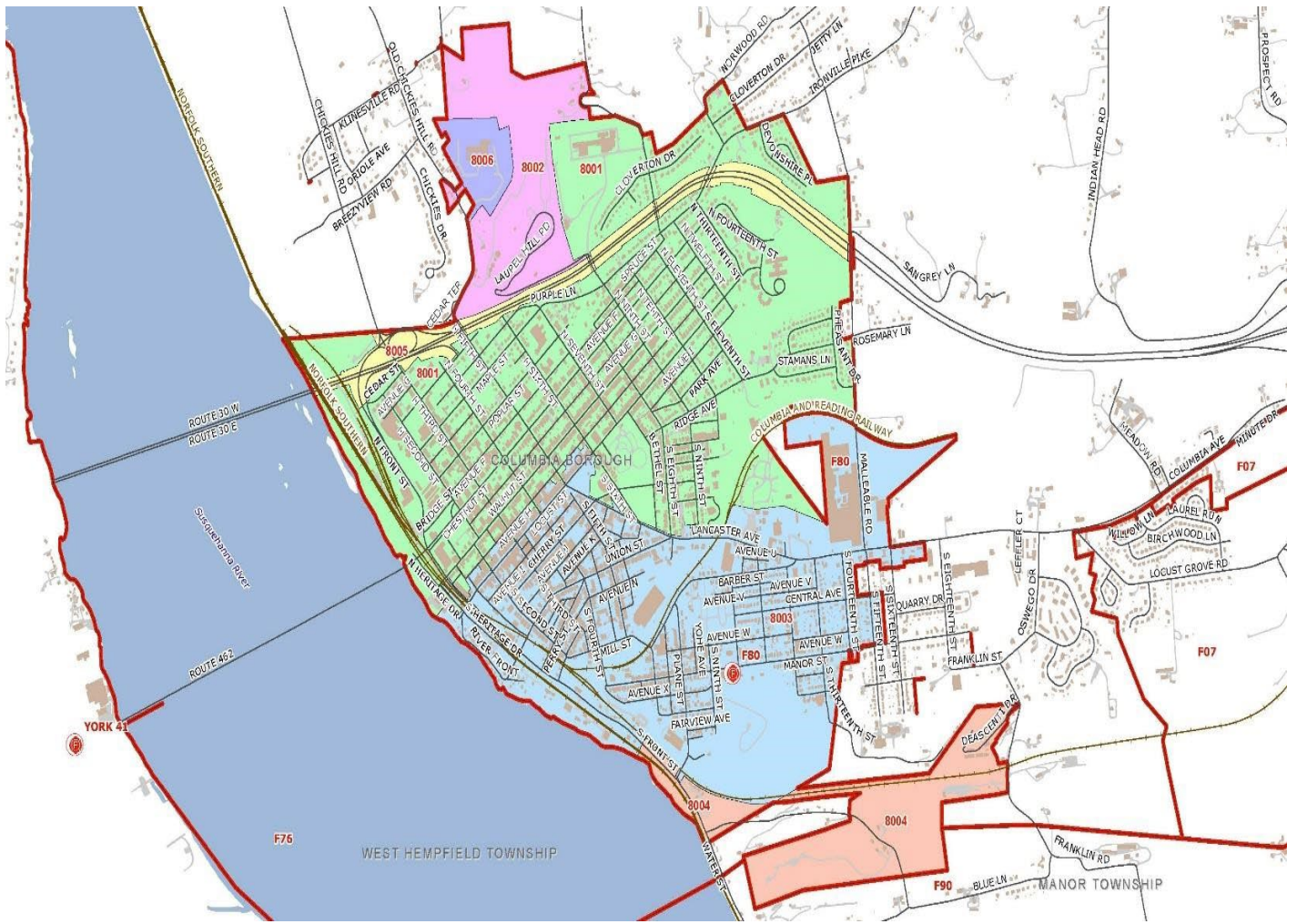
FEBRUARY INCIDENTS:
