- Sunday and Tuesday were our busiest days with 12 incidents each.
- Incidents by shifts and our average number of firefighters:
 - > 07:00am 02:59pm 26 incidents averaging 09.1 volunteers.
 - > 03:00pm 10:59pm 30 incidents averaging 16.9 volunteers.
 - > 11:00pm 06:59am 07 incidents averaging 10.4 volunteers.
 - All Shifts 63 incidents averaging 12.9 volunteers.



FIRE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES (PERCENT OF MAN HOURS):



- Fundraising totaled **27%** of our **January** Activities events with **116** man-hours.
- Public Education Specialists had 6 events with 12 man-hours:

 - > 01/08 Four smoke detectors installed the 800 Block Walnut Street, Columbia, PA.
 - > 01/16 One child safety seat was installed by our certified member, Lisa Splain.
 - > 01/18 Deputy Chief Kemmerly completed a fire safety inspection at the Columbia Library.
 - > 01/20 Assistant Chief Stock led a tour and safety talk to a Boy Scout Troop.
- Other activities for **January** that our Volunteers participated in were:
 - > 01/09 Truck 80 assisted with the symbolic "Arch", along with Red Lion Truck 34. This was set up for the passing of Denny Cunningham.
 - ▶ 01/22 Six members committed to staff the fire department for the weekend due to the winter storm Jonas. The members remained in station for a quick response to any emergency for the duration of the storm! This is shown as Duty Crew with 56% of our other monthly activities with 240 man-hours.
