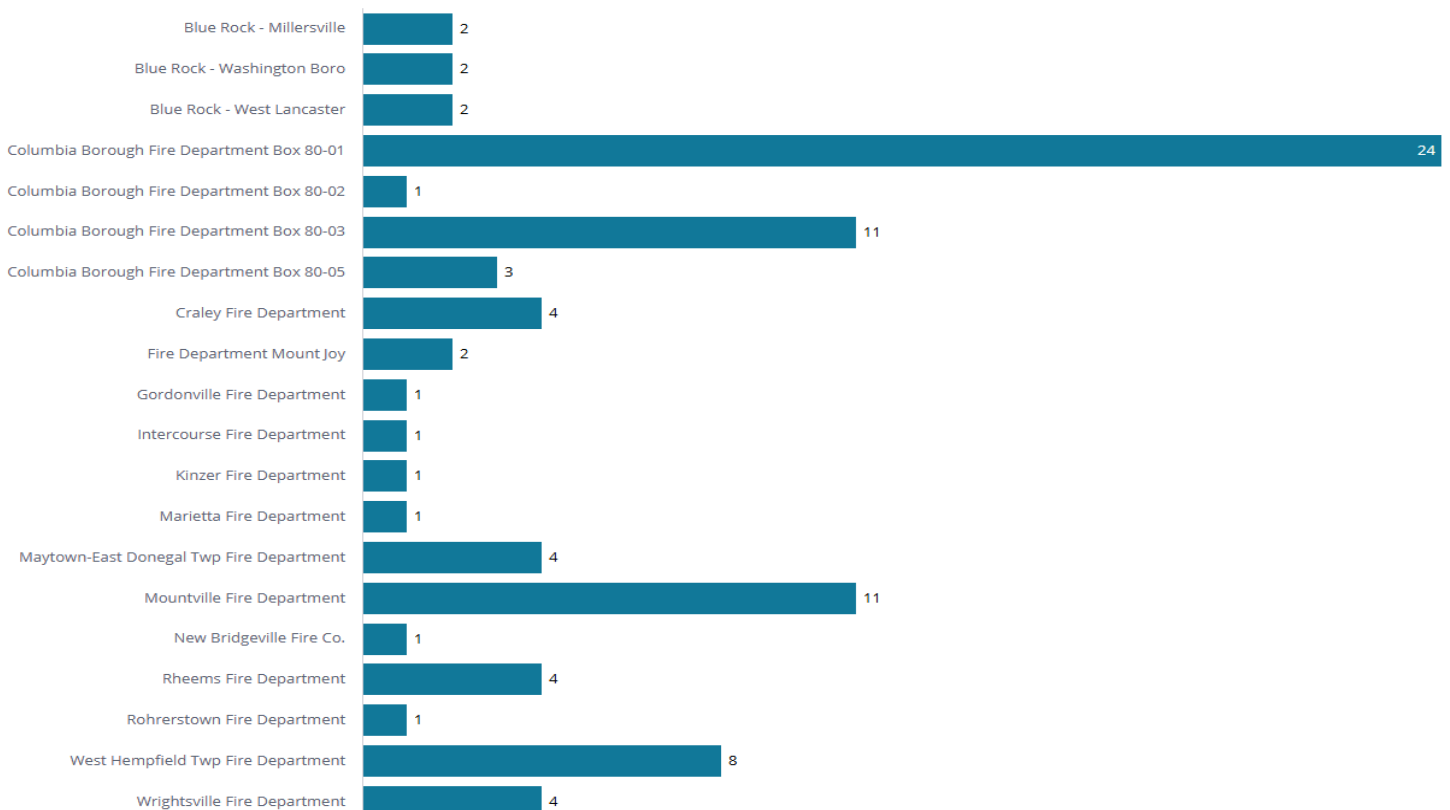

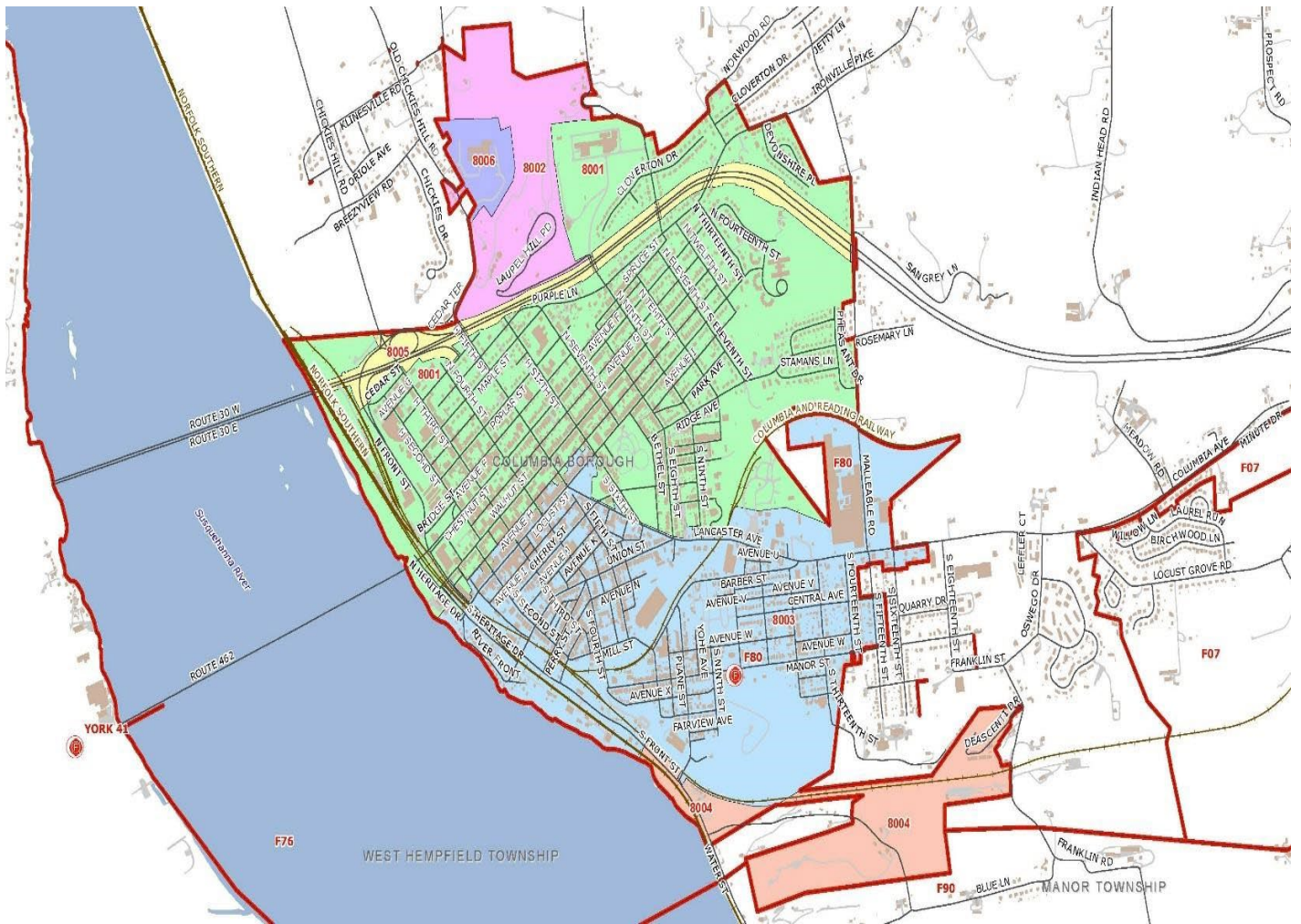
JANUARY INCIDENTS:
