- 0 firefighter exposures reported.
- Response time for first arriving fire truck in Columbia Borough (from dispatch to arrival) for the month of **July** was **6:16.**
- Saturday was our busiest day with 19 incidents.
- Incidents by shifts and our average number of volunteers:
 - > 07:00am 02:59pm 21 incidents averaging 09.7 volunteers.
 - > 03:00pm 10:59pm 27 incidents averaging 11.4 volunteers.
 - > 11:00pm 06:59am 10 incidents averaging 08.6 volunteers.
 - All Shifts 58 incidents averaging 10.3 volunteers.



Total Staff Hours by Training Category




