- 700 False Alarm Incidents including unintentional fire alarms.
- 800 False Alarm Incidents including malicious alarms, bomb scares.
- 900 Special Incidents including citizen complaints, special types and miscellaneous incidents,

- 48 dispatched fire incidents with 491 volunteer man-hours.
- \$260,000.00 of property was in danger of fire loss in Columbia Borough.
- \$100.00 of property was destroyed from fire in Columbia Borough.
- 0 firefighter injuries reported.
- 0 firefighter exposures reported.
- Response time for first arriving fire truck in Columbia Borough (from dispatch to arrival) for the month of May was 5:32.
- Friday was our busiest day with 10 incidents.

 - > 03:00pm 10:59pm 25 incidents averaging 12.1 volunteers.






FIRE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES (MAN HOURS):


