300	<b>Rescue/EMS Incidents including vehicle accidents, water rescue, searches, and industrial rescues.</b>
400	<b>Hazardous Materials Incidents including combustible spills, radioactive &amp; biological, and electrical issues.</b>
500	<b>Service Incidents including water removal, smoke/odor issue, animal issue, and public service.</b>
600	<b>Good Intent Incidents including unknown type of alarms, controlled burns, steam mistaken for smoke.</b>
700	<b>False Alarm Incidents including unintentional fire alarms.</b>
800	<b>False Alarm Incidents including malicious alarms, bomb scares.</b>
900	<b>Special Incidents including citizen complaints, special types and miscellaneous incidents.</b>

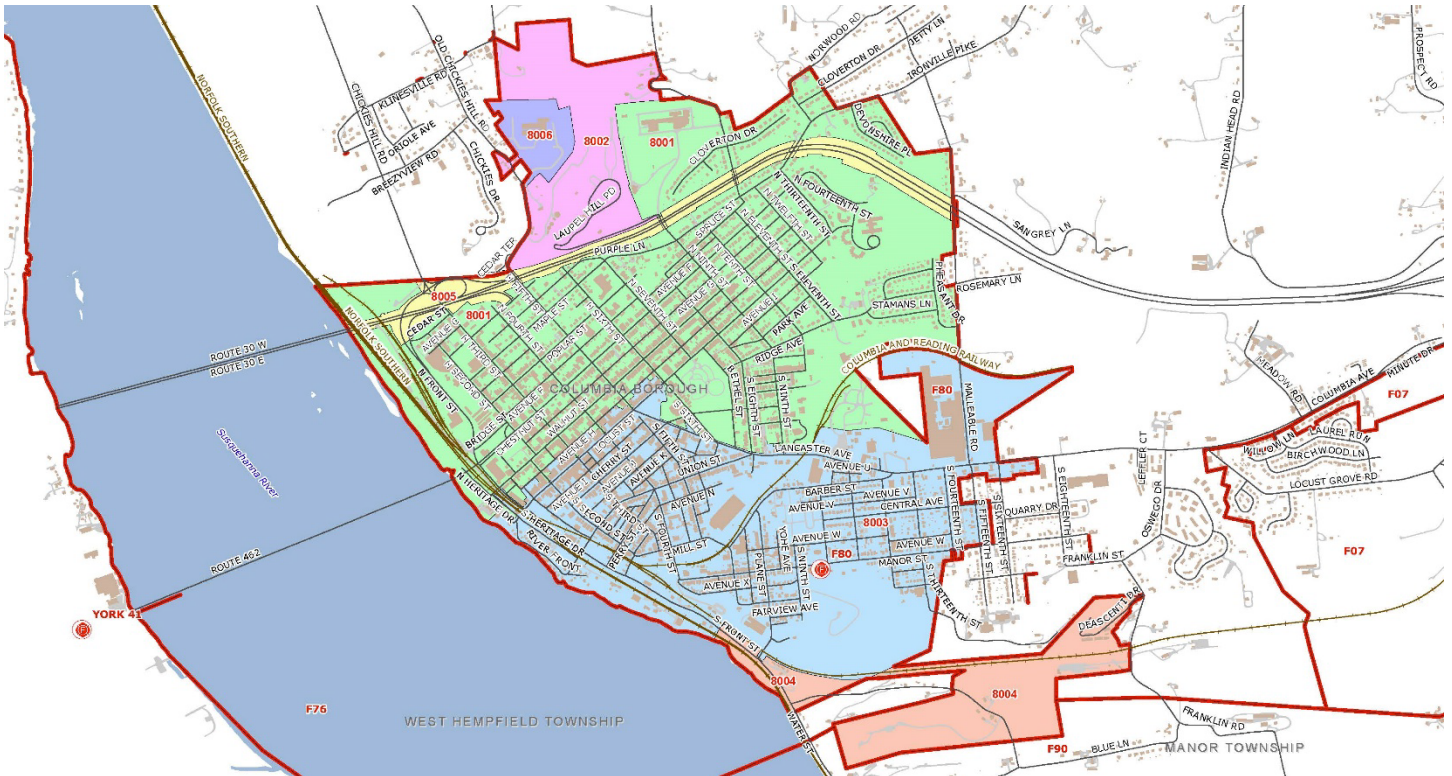
### JANUARY INCIDENTS:

- 61 dispatched fire incidents with 556 volunteer man-hours.
- 21 classes were attended for 35 volunteer man-hours.
- 16 activities were attended for 46 volunteer man-hours.
- **Tuesday** was our busiest day with 12 incidents.
- Incidents by shifts and our average number of volunteers:
  - 07:00am – 02:59pm 22 incidents.
  - 03:00pm – 10:59pm 33 incidents.
  - 11:00pm – 06:59am 6 incidents.
  - All Shifts 61 incidents.
- **Rescue/EMS** was our most dispatched incident type with 15.
